TELME EMERGENCY SYSTEM

You can store up to 4 emergency numbers (family, neighbours, friends, emergency services).

- In case of an emergency press and hold the emergency button. The emergency key will still work when the key lock is enabled.
- Press the emergency button to make an emergency call. Up to 4 numbers will be called in a predetermined order until the emergency call is answered.

This process is repeated 3 times.

Note: The phone does not recognize whether a person, an answering machine or voice mail takes off and sees this as a successful emergency!

- To abort the emergency call press long 🔂
- During the emergency call sequence, the mobile telephone sounds a warning signal to alert the people around you about the emergency.
- If no emergency number is stored, your prepaid-card has run out or you are outside of the reception area of your network operator, the international emergency number 112 will be called.

Note: If you want to save numbers from official services, police, firefighter, etc. as emergency numbers, you have to clarify this with these institutions. No liability will be assumed for possible costs incurred if you dial accidentally.

Saving emergency numbers:

Enter Menu *Settings* ⇒ *SOS-Settings* ⇒ *SOS Numbers* ⇒ Numbers. Highlight number (with up- and down-key) and press

1 ⇒ to select number. Now you enter the desired number and press *Save*: Im Menü *Einstellungen* ⇒ *SOS-Einstellungen* ⇒ *Status Ein/Aus* 1 Then confirm with *Yes*.

Note: select emergency number: private number (has to confirm as explained above) or official service number, e.g.: ambulance, police, etc. (no confirmation call required).

ALARM CLOCK:

on/off:

■ Press 7x △

<u>Edit</u>:

to set the alarm time and repetition (once, daily, individually).
<u>Turn off the alarm clock</u>: press M¹

<u>Mute</u>: press ^{M2} (the alarm clock will go on again after the preset time).

TOOLS

<u>Bluetooth</u>: Switch on: In the menu \triangle \Rightarrow *Bluetooth* $\boxed{M1}$ \Rightarrow *Power* $\boxed{M1}$.

Search audio device: M¹ to search for new devices ⇒ select device to be connected M¹ ⇒ Next time you switch on Bluetooth it will automatically be connected.

To choose a phone profile (e.g. silent) and configure your personal settings.

Call waiting:

You can activate/deactivate and check status to get a notification about an incoming call while having a phone talk.

Network settings:

Choose *automatic* (automatic boot in a network) or *manual* selection (select a network manually).

Auto power on/Auto power off

<u>Voicemail number</u>: Change the voicemail number <u>Security settings</u>: Activate, deactivate or change PIN and

phonecode (default phone code: 0000). **Restore Factory**: Reset the phone to factory settings.

Check the direction of the SIM card.

A call failed:

Check the selected telephone number and area code again for accuracy (area code entered?).

The mobile telephone display is blank/black:

Telephone is in energy saving mode (press keylock).
Or it is switched off _ press for 2 seconds to turn it on.

The mobile phone is not responding:

Remove battery, re-insert and switch on the device again. If still no response, please contact the Service Center.

The charging process will not start:

It may take a few minutes. If there's no response after 30 minutes, please contact the Service Center.








<u>Fig. 1</u>: Remove battery cover (as shown).





<u>Fig. 3</u>: Insert battery (gold contacts on right front side).














FIRST STEPS

Switch on:

the phone: press power on/off-key of for 2 sec. **Switch off**:

Note: The PIN-Code is a 4-digit number combination preventing others from switching on your mobile phone.

■ Switch off your PIN-Code: In menu: **Settings** ⇒ **Security Settings** ⇒ **PIN** ⇒ **PIN** off.

Tip: The first time you switch it on, you will be asked to enter the time and date using the number keypad, and confirm with $\boxed{\mathbb{N}}$ Furthermore your own telephone number and the device name will be shown: with $\boxed{\nabla}$ to "save" and press $\boxed{\mathbb{N}}$.

The device will switch off the illumination after a while in the case of inactivity. To switch the illumination on again, press any button once.

Incoming call:

Handsfree Speaking: To talk without holding the phone to your ear, switch on/off the handsfree function during a call: press M2 Handsfree.

Save names and numbers (always with international dialling code, e.g. +49 for Germany, +43 for Austria, +41 for Switzerland).

Storing phone book entries (Name & Number):

Enter phone book with

- ⇒ select if you want to add your contact to the SIM or to the phone. Edit name and number by pressing *Edit* M¹. Refer to chapter for writing instructions. Press *Back* M² to save your entry. A pop-up appears. Press *Yes* M¹.

Searching phone book entries:

open the phone book with: ▽

- \Rightarrow Scroll through the entries with $\overline{\nabla}$ and $\overline{\triangle}$ or
- Search names: enter the initial letters of the searched name via the keypad (scroll through with ▽. When the requested name is shown, press ເ to start a call.

TEXT MESSAGE (SMS)

SMS (Short Message Service) is a short text message, up to 160 characters in length.

<u>Writing text</u>: Enter menu with △ ⇒ enter *New SMS* oder *New multimedia message* (MMS), if you want to send pictures with 🏡.

Choose Write message with . Entering text with the keypad. Every key represents several signs, depending on how often you press the key.
